



The Bon Art Junior Fest reveals its finalists: Young singers from all over the world will go head-to-head at Prague's Hybernia Theatre! The event is also establishing a partnership with the Dagmar and Václav Havel Foundation VIZE 97

The international singing talent competition Bon Art Junior Fest knows all its finalists. From dozens of international applications, the expert jury selected four young talents who will compete with the Czech finalists at the final gala evening, which takes place on **23 October 2024** at the Hybernia Theatre in Prague.

The following singers **from abroad** reached the finals: Tamara Bartková (Slovakia), Adelina Maria Nedelcu (Romania), Katerina Voznyak (Ukraine) Zac Efen Domingo (Philippines). For the **Czech Republic**, the following earned their place in the final: Valerie Vylíčilová, Valerie Stojková, Anna Šafaříková, Jonáš Morávek, Viktorie Molcarová and Thea Šírová.

The final gala evening, which promises an unforgettable experience full of music and emotions, will offer not only solo performances by contestants, but also several joint performances. The competitors will be accompanied by **the ladies symphony orchestra Bon Art Pops Orchestra** under the direction of **Felix Slováček Jr.**

The evening's winner will take home a prize of €4,000, but the competition is all about supporting young talents for whom this success can open doors to the world of professional music.

Guests of the evening will include famous personalities of the music scene, such as **Marta Jandová, Peter Nagy, Lenny, Marpo, Jana Sibera, Radim Schwab, Monika Sommerová**. Some of these will also be members of the jury, which will include Katka Žbirková, Jan Bors, Michaela A. Dobrovolná, Miloslav Zýka and others. The final evening will be hosted by well-known presenters Tereza Tobiášová and Jan Čenský.

The Dagmar and Václav Havel Foundation VIZE 97 and Bon Art Junior Fest join forces to support the education of talented music students.

This year, the Bon Art Junior Fest competition established a partnership with the Dagmar and Václav Havel Foundation VIZE 97. The foundation VIZE 97 supports talented music students with the programme **"Supporting the Education of Talented Music Students"**. This initiative aims to support young musicians who, due to financial difficulties, cannot afford a quality musical education.

"It would be hugely disappointing to lose talented young musicians just because studying at a business academy will bring them a faster income than studying at a conservatory", explains the founder of the Foundation, Dagmar Havlová. "Music education and practice simply takes longer, and not every family can afford a musical instrument or tuition", she adds.

At the final gala evening, the Dagmar and Václav Havel Foundation VIZE 97 will be presented with €4,000 from the organiser of the Bon Art Junior Fest, the same amount as the winner of the competition, as a symbolic gesture of support for young talents and their education.
